



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In-flight Entertainment

Nowadays, many flights that are more than four or five hours long feature some forms of in-flight entertainment. In-flight entertainment refers to the system that an airline provides the entertainment to its passengers during a long time.

There are varieties of entertainment in flight.



Moving-map System

A moving-map system is a real-time flight information broadcast through the video screens and personal televisions (PTVs). In addition to displaying a map that illustrates the position and direction of the plane, the system gives the altitude, airspeed, outside air temperature, distance to the destination, distance from the origination point, and local time. The moving-map system information is derived in real-time from the aircraft's flight computer systems.



Video System

Video entertainment is provided via a large video screen at the front of a cabin section, as well as smaller monitors situated every few rows above the aisles. The sound is supplied via the headsets. It covers music, as well as films, news, information, and drama. In addition, there is a channel devoted to the plane's radio communications, allowing passengers to listen to the pilots' in-flight conversations with other planes and ground stations.



Game System

Video games are another emerging facet of in-flight entertainment. Some game systems are networked to allow interactive playing by multiple passengers. Later generations of in-flight entertainment games began to shift focus from pure entertainment to learning. Many more learning applications continue to appear in the in-flight entertainment market.

Just before the aircraft reaches its destination, the cabin attendants should collect the headsets. It is important that each headset should be accounted for. Cabin attendants also write a report as to the operation of the entertainment system, to indicate whether any equipment needs to be repaired.

Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi is the most commonly used local wireless data network standard that allows electronic devices to exchange data. It allows you to connect a Web-enabled device to the Internet wirelessly. Now Wi-Fi can be used on the flight. But if you want to use this service in flight, you should know the following points.

Pre-flight Preparations

Bring Your Devices


In accordance with² the regulations³ of CAAC⁴, the mobile phones must be turned off throughout the flight. Please bring laptop or tablet PC⁵ with the Wi-Fi function⁶.

Download the Common Use Application

China Southern in-flight Wi-Fi is capable of⁷ web browsing⁸, instant⁹ messaging, e-mail, etc. We currently do not provide audio/video streaming¹⁰ service.

Log into¹¹ Personal Account¹²

Some applications (e.g. WeChat¹³ and QQ) may require QR code¹⁴ verification¹⁵ when you login¹⁶ at different devices. We suggest you complete the verification and login before boarding to ensure the normal use during the flight.




Three Simple Steps to Access In-flight Wi-Fi

On some China Southern flights, you can enjoy in-flight Wi-Fi service by taking three simple steps to complete connection:

1. Turn on your device and make sure the Wi-Fi function is ON.
 2. Connect the Wi-Fi network “CSAIR17” manually¹⁸, and set the security option¹⁹ to “WPA20/WPA2” or “WPA2”.
 3. Run your web browser, enter any URL²¹ or www.flycsair.com and complete the identity verification.
- Then you can experience our in-flight Wi-Fi service.
