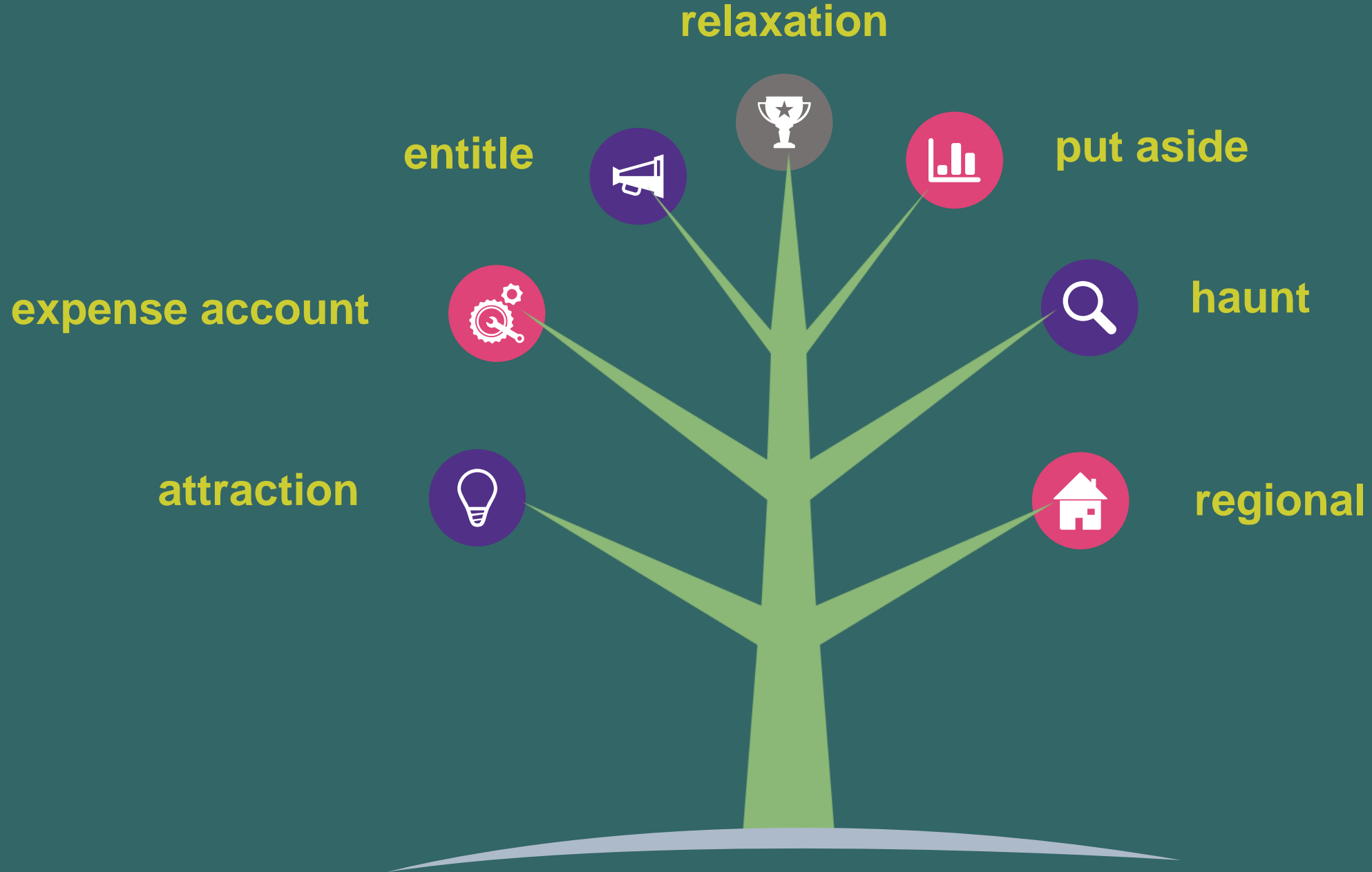

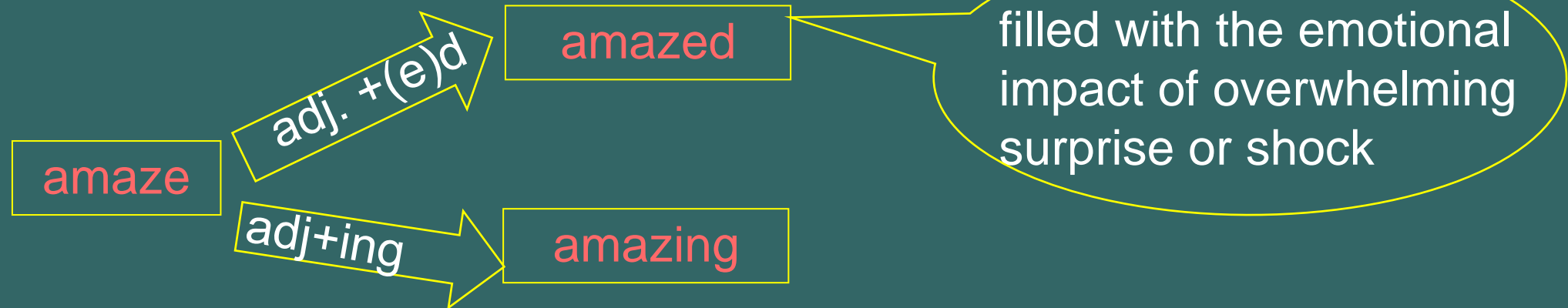
3 Word usage

a. very good, especially in an unexpected way

e.g. It's **amazing** how quickly people adapt to their environment.

take advantage of

make use of something well, properly

e.g. They took full advantage of the hotel's facilities.

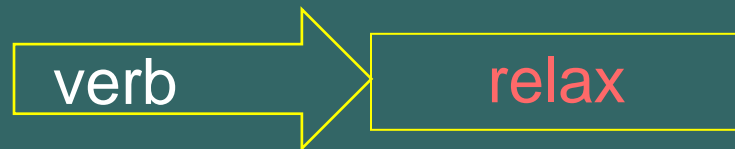
3 Word usage



relaxation

n. ways of resting and enjoying yourself; time spent resting and enjoying yourself

e.g. His day is evenly divided between work and relaxation.



3 Word usage



put aside

v. to decide not to deal with something; to save something for later use

e.g. Will you please **put aside** your work and listen to me for one minute?

v. to save something for later use

e.g. She **puts aside** 1,000 yuan every month for her son's future education.

3 Word usage



secure

v. to obtain or achieve something, especially after a lot of effort

e.g. She **secured** 2,000 votes in the general election.

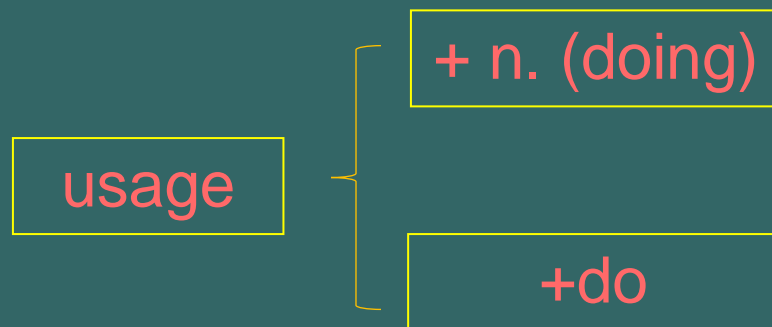

to have the right to have or do something

e.g. If one side failed to honor the contract, the other side should **be entitled to** cancel it.



e.g. You will **be entitled to** your pension when you reach 65.
