- 5、具有一定的语言技巧,能够应对业务中的突发情况。

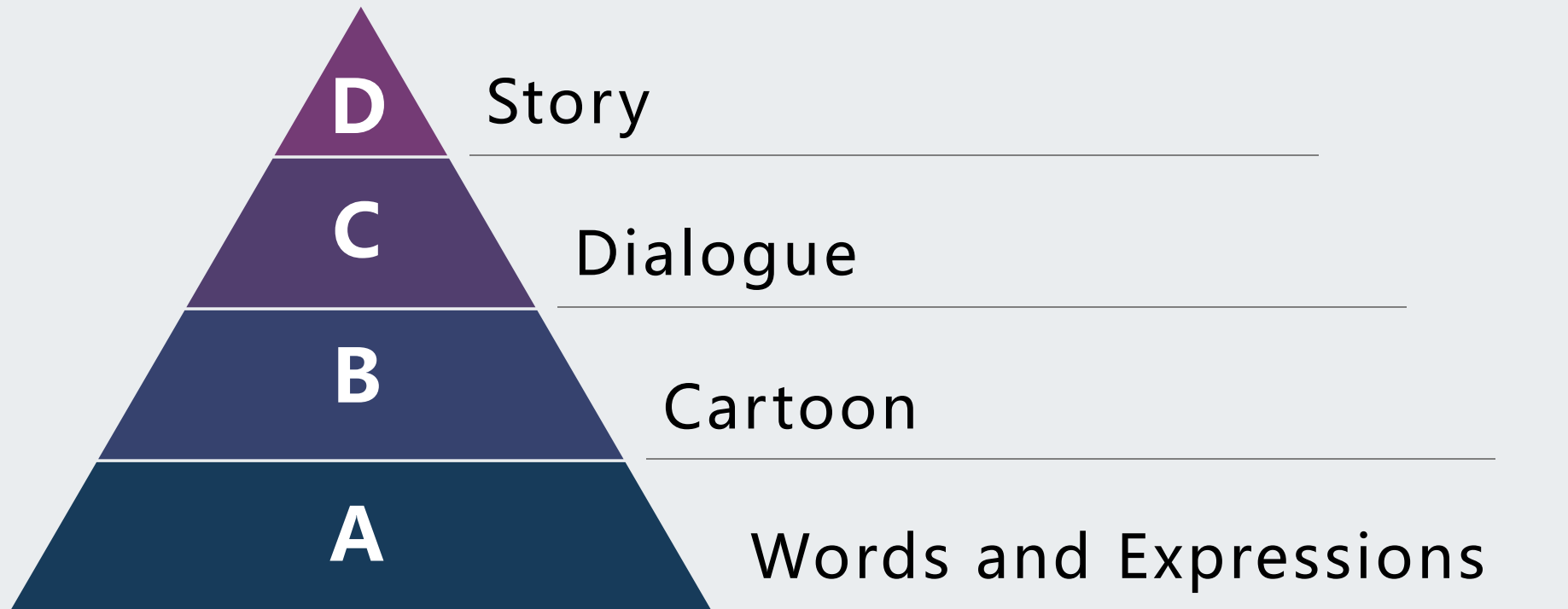
## 知识目标:

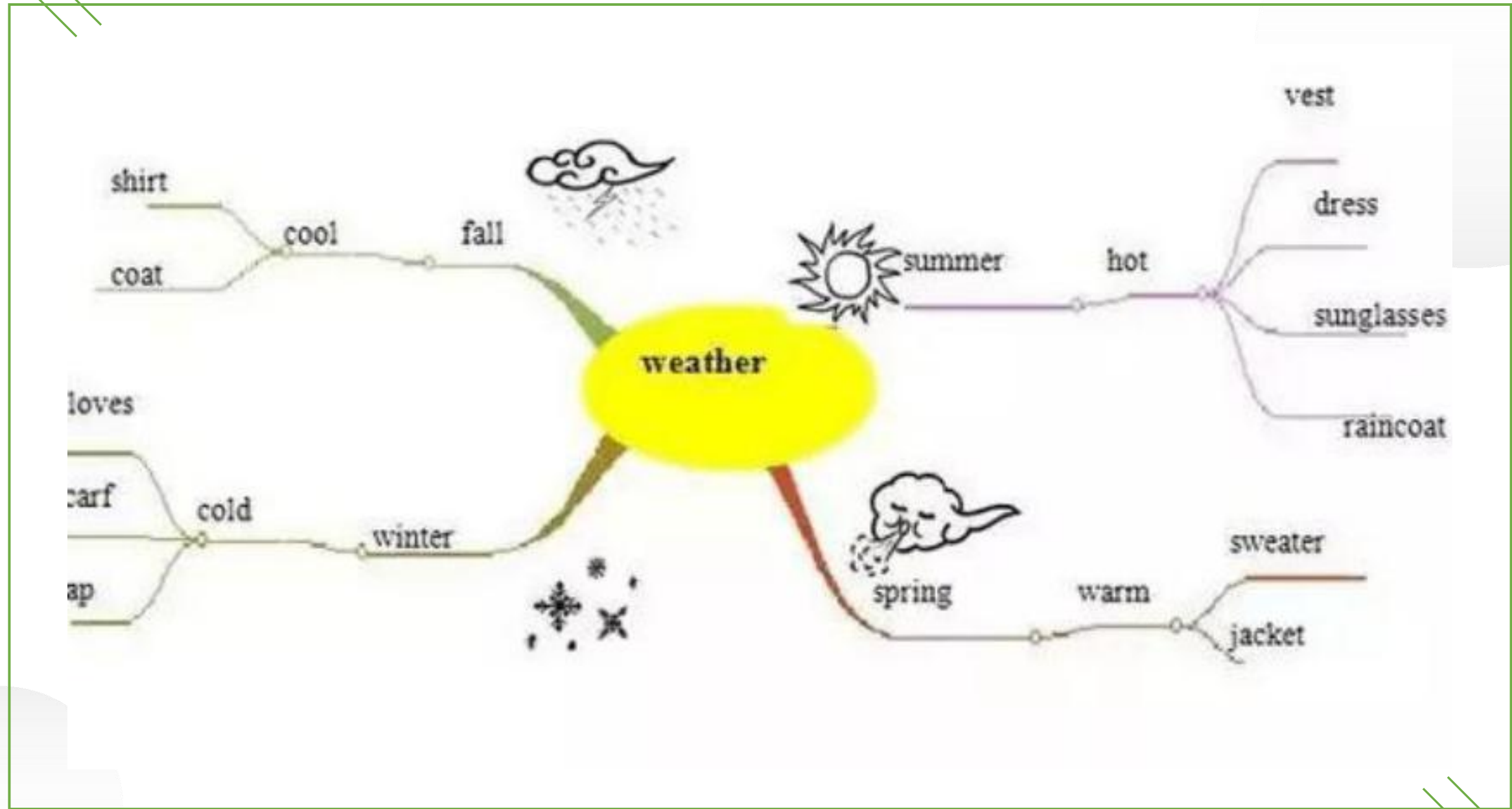

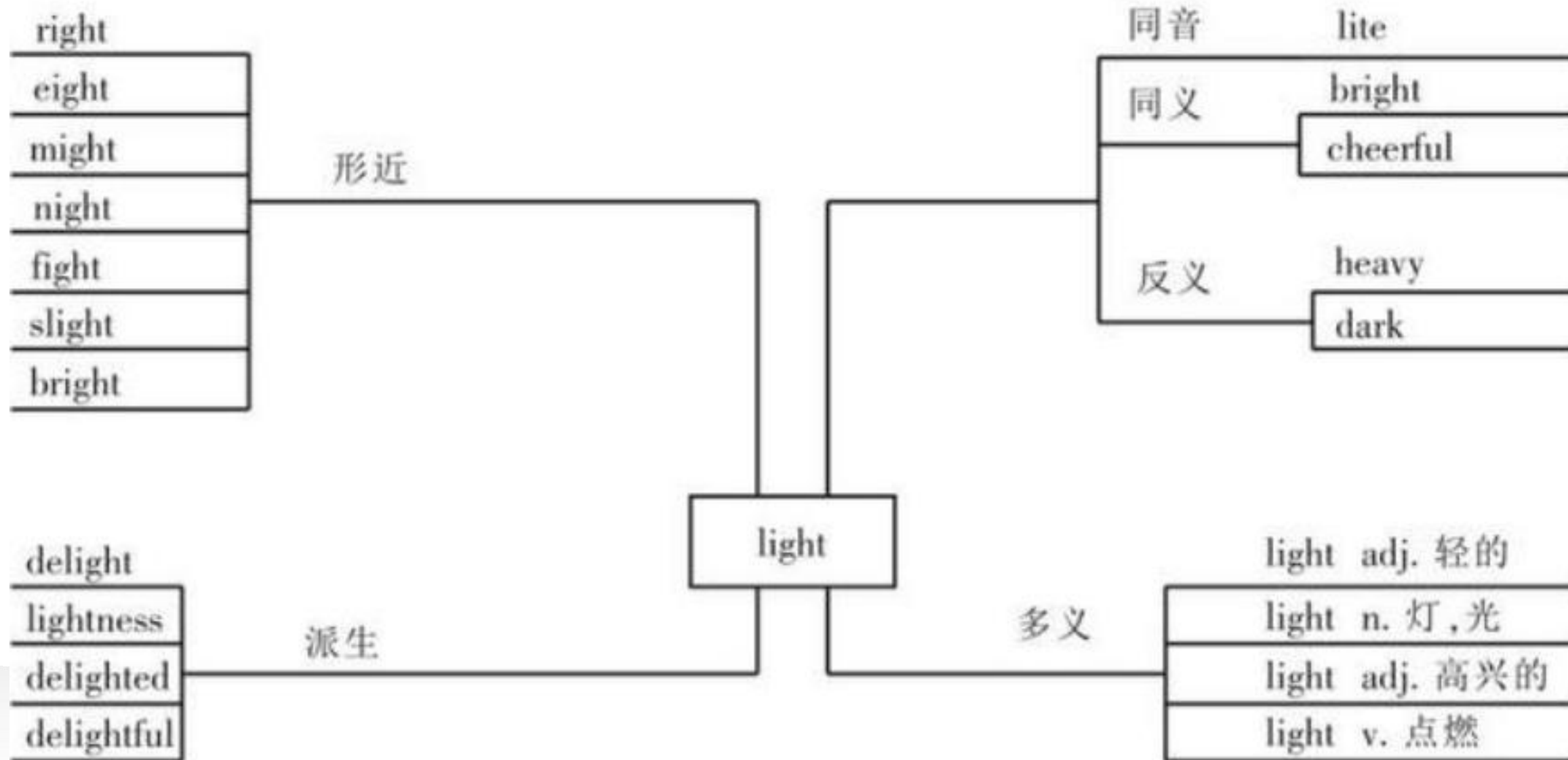

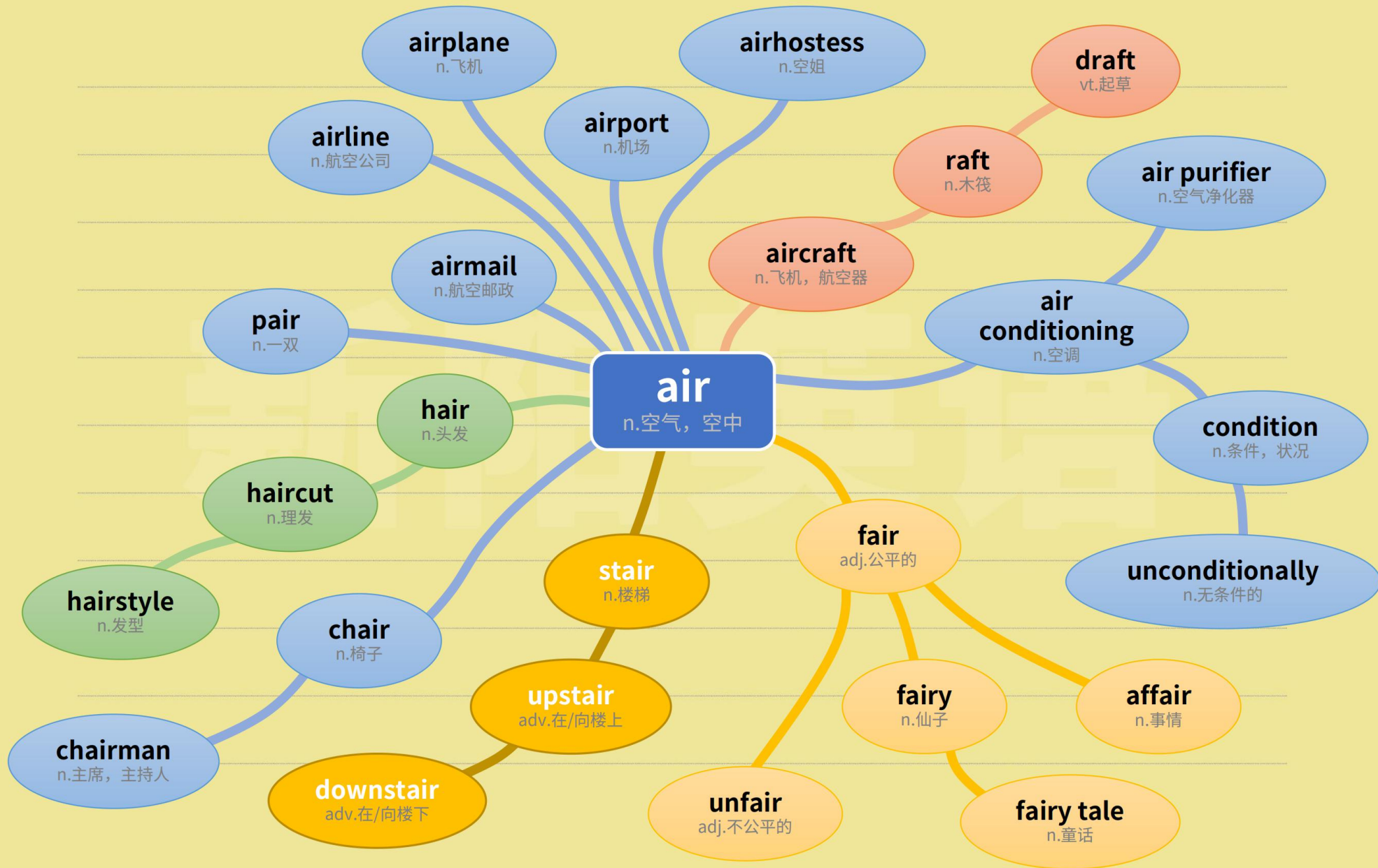

<b>den</b>	the home of a wild animal



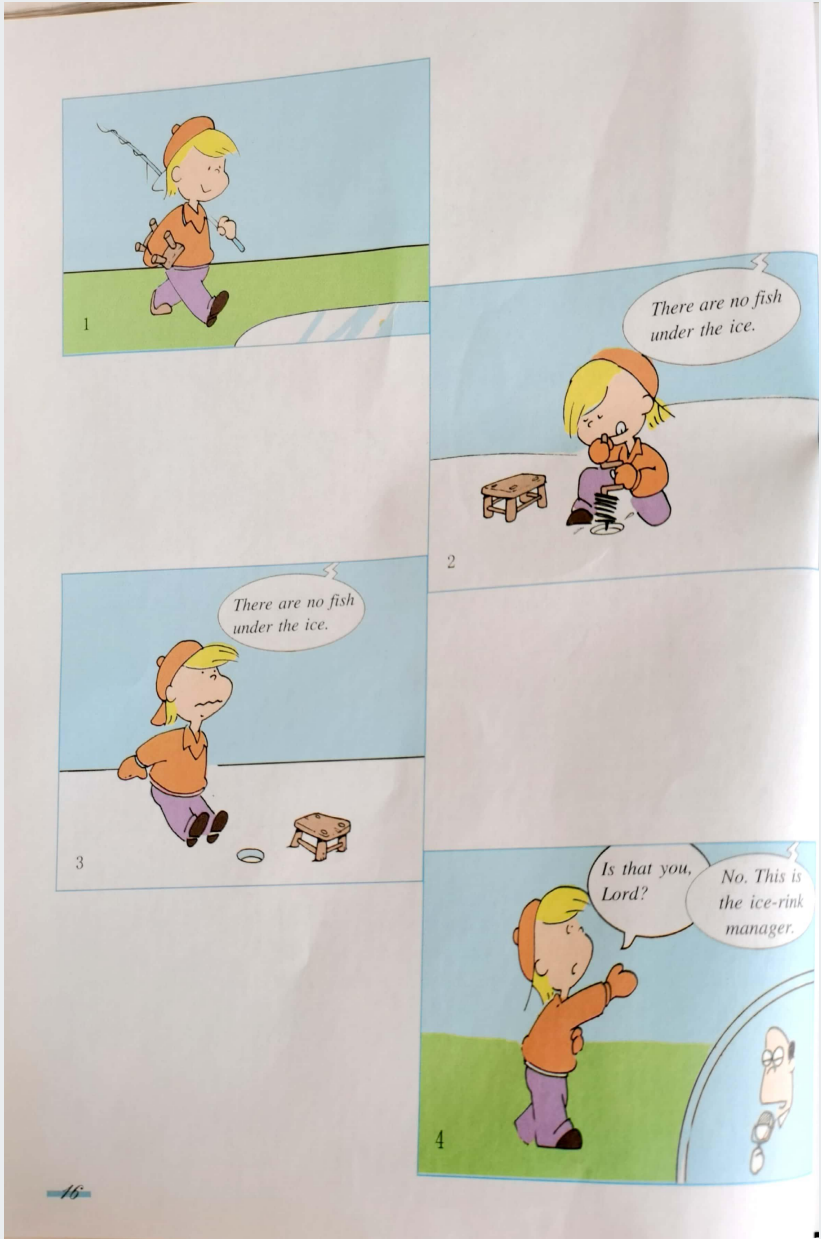


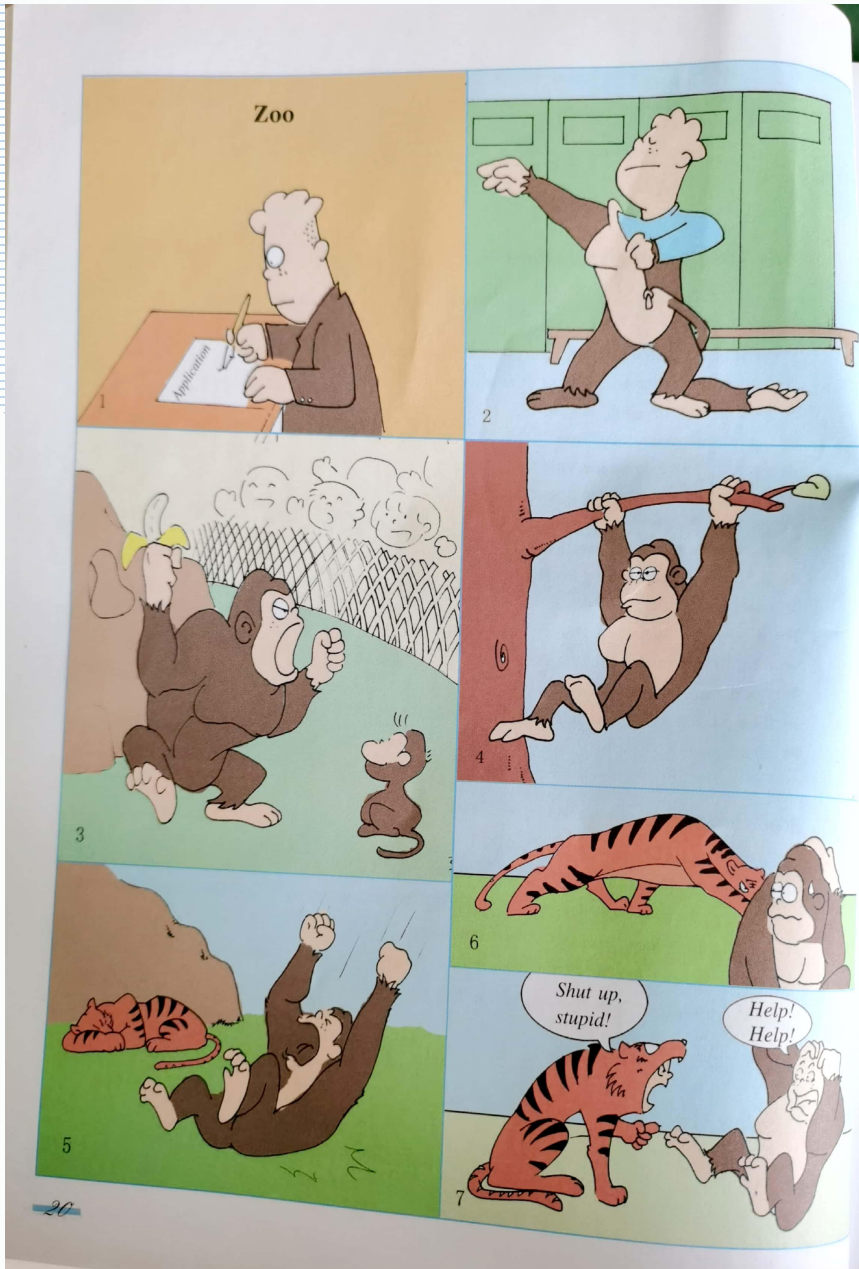
