

*n.* the amount of something

e.g.

- The **volume** of traffic on the roads has increased dramatically in recent years.
- the **volume** of trade

### 3 Word usage



advantageous

v. good or useful in a particular situation

e.g. A free trade agreement would be advantageous to both countries.

### 3 Word usage



namely

*ad.* that is (to say)

e.g.

- Three students were mentioned, **namely** John, Sarah and Tony.
- There are five major modes of transport for goods, **namely**, rail transport, water transport, road transport, pipeline transport and air transport.

# Sentence patterns



**characterize**

v. to describe the qualities of someone or something in a particular way

e.g. The group was **characterized** as being well-educated.

## Sentence patterns

**P1:** Each mode of transport **is characterized by** different carriers.



be characterized by

*= to have the character or qualities of*

*e.g.* Your work **is characterized** by lack of attention to details.

# Sentence patterns



## comparison

*n.* the process of comparing two or more people or things

*e.g.* You can't make a comparison between American and Japanese schools – they're too different.

## Sentence patterns

**P5:** In comparison with other carriers, they offer an economical way to transport ...

in comparison with 比较

*e.g. In comparison with the male, the female is stronger and more energetic.*
