

1. Sender Information

Add your address details, phone and FedEx account number.

2. Recipient

For the reliable delivery, full and clear details are needed.

3. Shipment Information

Be specific and detailed.

List each commodity separately.

Enter the selling price or fair market value of your shipment contents.



4. Transportation Charges

Select a method of payment and provide the appropriate FedEx Express account number or credit card number.

5. Your Internal Billing

Check/

To help with your records, use this optional area for your internal shipping numbers. We'll print the first 24 characters on your invoice.

6. Required Signature

Finally sign the Air Waybill, remove the sender's copy and place the remaining copies with your shipment.
